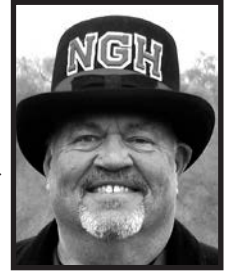

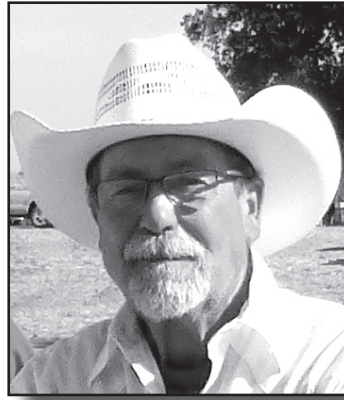

GOT MILK

Who were our Portuguese ancestors? Where and how did they become great Americans? It all started with the first Portuguese to land in California. 1595 Sebastian Rodriguez Cermeno landed his ship at Drakes Bay in Northern California. A great storm developed and put his ship aground and destroyed it. Using resources and a lot of help from local Miwok Indians, he obtained large draft boats and sailed them to San Blas Mexico. 1679 a Jesuit Priest Eusebio Kino brought dairy cows to Baja California as part of the mission establishment plans. 1767 Jesuits (Spain) were expelled by the Dominican Religious Establishment. The Franciscan Dominicans began their work to establish the 21 Missions through out California. 1773 around March, Father Serra waiting for a ship to take him from San Blas, Mexico to California where he saw large herds of dairy cows. He requested the church to send cows to California. 1775 Father Juan Boutista (a Portuguese) brought around 1,000 plus dairy and range cows to California from Mexico by land. By 1840's young Portuguese men from the Azores were being hired as ship hands, these ships came to Mexico and to California for trade in tallow and cow hides. Upon the discovery of "GOLD" and the news of the same, the Portuguese trading ships came to San Francisco, where these young men "Jumped Ship" and went to find their fortunes.

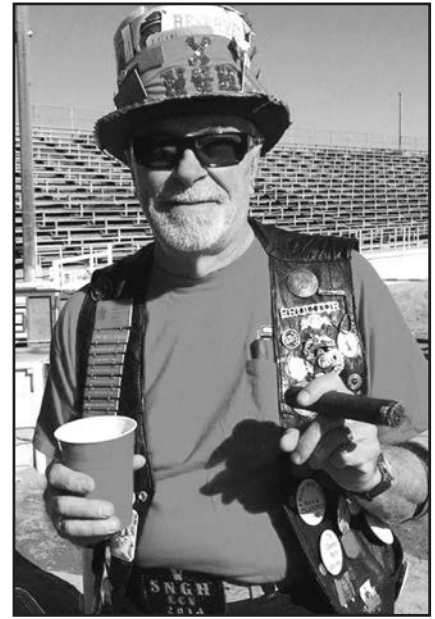
As we are so aware, many people including a lot of these Portuguese miners did not get rich, so they came to the San Joaquin Valley and to the large dairy farms around Marin, California. They settled in and started their families, In the beginning the men worked as hired helpers, sheep herders, cow milkers (aka "Milk Hanas"). Farm ranch hands etc.. They worked very hard, both men, women and their children to create a new life. They saved their money and became share-cropper's, then land owners. The Portuguese communities banded together for their mutual success. Being Roman Catholics, the church had a strong influence upon their lives. Annually these Azorians Portuguese celebrated the annual Festival of the "Holy Ghost Festa" and culminating with the crowning of their young girls. The Portuguese endured many hardships as well as others during this countries recessions, crop failures, 1908 Bubonic Plague, and many government restrictions. Through all of this, the Portuguese Dairyman grew their herd and by 1915 they produced more than half of all the milk in California. By 1960 they had produced over 90% of all the milk in California, There are over 330,000 Portuguese residents living in California. Today they have developed their own marketing plans through the use of associations with the "Milk Producers Association" and the "American Dairy Company" to protect their prices and businesses.

In California there are (5) main dairy producing counties, Tulare, Merced, Stanislaus, Kings and Kern. The Portuguese Dairies milk, Black/White Holsteins, Jersey, Brown Swiss, Guernsey and Ayrshire cows as their main milking stock. As we have seen above the Portuguese people are great citizens, family members and great Americans who have contributed to our American Society.

No baseball hats, t-shirts, shorts, etc. Everyone had a good time and we even did a Gentlemen’s Initiation. It was so well received that we are going to make it an annual event, probably in the Spring.

As many of you know we lost our Waterford Clubhouse due to a raise in the rent that was beyond our means. We have been able to find storage for all our stuff from a friendly Clamper brother for a mere pittance. In the Hewgag following that event there was a picture he took on his way down and you can see the ECV spelled out by the redshirts. It was cool. 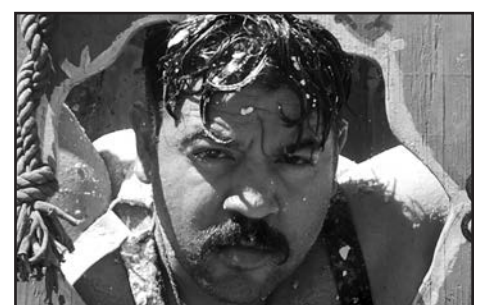

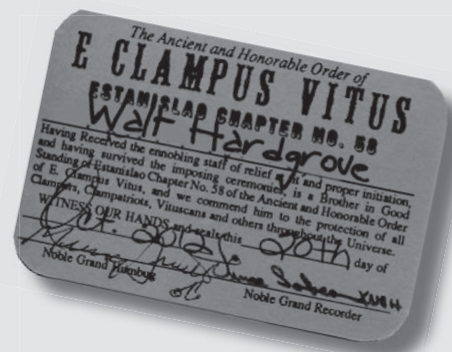
